There must be sufficient time to mobilise support and integrate partners with vested and aligned interests

Importance to engage sectorial and social participation not only the environmental sector

From Day 1, it seems best to link up and formalize arrangements with government policy makers first so that funding and work plans are streamlined

Harmonization of approaches, targets and indicators, for scaled-up delivery

Just knowing what others are doing and how they are going about it. Lessons for success and barriers so that technology transfer and adoption enhanced.

Opportunities to partner are readily available, especially by institutions that have complimentary or similar activities, with management of expectations on support from partnership key.
